#### National Volunteer week

#### NAPLAN 2021

Over the past two weeks our Year 3, 5 and 7 students have been participating in NAPLAN tests consisting of reading, writing, language conventions and numeracy. The NAPLAN assessments provide a snapshot of your child's progress; it is another way to find out what students are able and not able to do under these types of conditions. Students have had opportunities to become familiar with the NAPLAN online test format before they sit the assessments. Schools will receive results in the coming months.
