Site Improvement Plan

The leadership team are currently reviewing our progress and achievement against the goals and targets in our Site Improvement Plan. What the review has highlighted is we have a number of students who achieved outstanding levels of progress this year, in both writing and reading. This is hugely pleasing for us as staff as it validates the work we have all been doing. For the students, experiencing positive growth and achievement in reading leads to greater engagement in all areas of learning as well as their overall wellbeing. In 2023, we will continue to refine and strengthen our explicit teaching of the reading comprehension strategies, to ensure students are able to make sense of what they are reading in all contexts and learning areas at their developmentally appropriate level.

Kindy transition visits

Our Kindy transition visits are about to start. The Kindy students will be visiting on Wednesday, commencing in Week 5, for three weeks. They will be on site from 9am - 12pm. During the transition visits, both Mrs Kearns and Mrs Schultz's current receptions will be in room 22A and 22B to continue with their learning with another teacher. The current Reception children may have the opportunity to play with the Kindy students during recess.

Staffing and class updates for 2023

Thank you to those parents/carers who took the time to provide information they thought was important when placing their child in a class for 2023. At this stage it looks like we will begin next year with 11 classes. We are continuing to monitor enrolments and over the next few weeks we will begin to look at classes and staffing for 2023. Some staff news we can confirm is that Jemma Worroll, currently at Tanunda Primary School, has won the Student Wellbeing Leader position at that site for the next 3 years. Congratulations Jemma. The process has commenced to appoint a Student Wellbeing Leader at Kapunda Primary School for 2023. We will also be commencing soon temporary teacher and ancillary positions for 2023. As we continue to look at budgets for 2023, for planning purposes, it is extremely important we have up to date information regarding student enrolments. A notice went home recently requesting information about your children and whether they will be attending Kapunda Primary School in 2023. We have used this information to determine indicative classes for 2023.





PASTORAL CARE WORKER




