

Warning Sirens

Type of Siren	Action
3 short blasts of siren	<p style="text-align: center;">Wet weather</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and staff return to classrooms • Once weather clears, students and staff can return outside
10 short blasts of siren	<p style="text-align: center;">Evacuation</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and staff assemble on the oval (northern end football goals) • Staff check roll books and hold up to signal all present
1 continuous blast of siren <u>(1 minute minimum)</u>	<p style="text-align: center;">Invacuation</p> <p>Lesson time/Inside play</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Students and staff to remain in classrooms/room • Lock door • Under desks and blinds down • If in yard / toilets, students need to move quickly to nearest classroom • Check students present and wait for phone call <p>Out of classroom (e.g. playtime)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <u>All students to the gym</u> • Lock the gym • Teachers sit students at carpark end of gym in class rows • Check the roll using lists in gym bag and wait for phone call • At the conclusion of the incident, students and staff can return outside

The siren can be manually operated from the Data Room (Behind front counter, in admin) – push the **GREEN BUTTON**.

After Hours – In the event of an evacuation after hours please assemble on the oval – Northern end.
