# NAPLAN Changes for 2023

## New proficiency standards for NAPLAN reporting

From 2023, new proficiency standards apply to NAPLAN reporting.

This new proficiency reporting replaces the 10 numerical NAPLAN reporting bands and the national minimum standard. Education ministers agreed 2023 was the right time to introduce this change alongside moving NAPLAN to March.

The new reporting has 4 proficiency levels:

Proficiency level	What it means
Exceeding	The student's result exceeds expectations at the time of testing.
Strong	The student's result meets challenging but reasonable expectations at the time of testing
Developing	The student's result indicates that they are working towards expectations at the time of testing.
Needs additional support	The student's result indicates that they are not achieving the learning outcomes expected at the time of testing. They are likely to need additional support to progress satisfactorily.
